

Dr. & Mrs. L.F. Heath Scholarship Application

Application and Guidelines

Applicant must use the official scholarship application. It must be dated and signed by both parent and student. ***Typewritten applications are preferred over handwritten applications.***

Completed Applications

Applications must be 3-hole punched and placed in a 3-ring binder, and should not exceed 20 pages.

Employment and Community Service

List jobs held and community service performed from **January 2023 – December 2023**. Please list total hours worked.

Honors and Awards

In the Honors and Awards section, do not include awards such as Academic letter, honor roll, perfect attendance, Scout Merit badges, top percent of class and Who's Who. The above list is not inclusive. ***Activity sheets are acceptable replacements for the Employment and Community Service and Honors and Awards sections. Activity sheets must be structured identically to the application.***

Applicant Essay

The applicant must prepare an essay of 350 words or less stating the following: What in your life has had the major influence in your high school accomplishments, determining career aspirations, achieving these life goals and preparing for college. ***Essay must be dated and signed.***

Parental/Guardian Financial Statement

The applicant must submit the following documents: A fully completed Free Application for Federal Student and Aid form (FAFSA), a statement of 200 words or less summarizing the family's obligations and resources. The statement should illustrate the applicants need for financial assistance and the inability to meet these needs, including any extenuating circumstances. ***Must be signed and dated.***

Transcript, Report Card and SAT/ACT Scores

Include official current high school transcript, a copy of last report card issued and SAT or ACT test scores (if not included on official transcript).

Two Letters of Recommendation

Include one letter of recommendation from a high school teacher. The letter may include the applicant's qualities, work habits, leadership, personality and integrity. The second letter must be from a community member (no relation to applicant). The letter may include the applicant's participation in community work service, leadership skills and outstanding recognition. Letters must be limited to a one-sided single sheet (8.5x11) of paper. ***Must be typed, dated and signed.***

Exhibits

Attach copies of exhibits of achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, drama, community service, or any other activities the applicant is involved in, but avoid repetition.

Application Deadline is May 28, 2024.

Scoring:

Financial Need-FAFSA	600 Points
Scholarship-ACT/SAT/GPA	400 Points
Total:	1000 Points

In case of a tie "Leadership" will be considered.
Components of "Leadership" to be evaluated are:
Honors/Awards, Positions of Leadership, Organization participation, Employment/Community Service.

Custodial Parent:

If your parents are divorced or separated, answer the questions for the parent you lived with the most in the past 12 months. If you lived with both parents equally in the past 12 months, you will use the parent who provided you with the greatest amount of support, financially as well as materially. Material things would include clothing, medical and dental payments, cars etc.. If that parent is remarried, you must include the stepparent's information as well.

Scholarship Award:
